In the early 80's Bowlers in the Kardinya area called a meeting of all interested parties and the end result was the forming of the Kardinya Bowling Club.

The City of Melville offered land within the Morris Buzacott Reserve. The Club started to form and the first Bowling Club in Perth metro to have Synthetic Greens became a reality.

The first club rooms and bar was formed from shipping containers. This was used until the club became financial enough to self fund the club rooms as they are today. We were also the first to have retractable sun shades fitted to both of the greens in line with our duty of care principals. Again this was a self funded investment.

The Kardinya Bowling Club has had quite a successful life,

Winning club of the year twice.
Winning many Pennant's in both Mid Week
and Saturday Interclub seasons.

Over the years the club has grown to a current financial membership of over 200. We have one of the highest numbers of teams in the Midweek and Saturday competitions.

Why would you bother?

The club is a non-profit organisation with no paid employees.

To provide a friendly, appealing and successful club for our community there are many things that must be managed.

All work such as green keeping, bar management, food preparation, ground maintenance, building maintenance and so on is done by volunteers.

Occasionally, we also have to undertake various costly projects such as building extensions, synthetic surface replacement. Electrically operated sun protection cover replacement. We are about to extend the premises and will look at installing solar panels to reduce the cost of power. This all takes money.

Support the local community

Bowls is a great game and we'd like to better promote the game to the local community by involving schools, local companies, organisations and sporting clubs. To do this effectively we need to invest in facilities. This will also promote partnership companies in many ways.

The club has just recently hosted the very



successful 2018 Multi-Disability
Lawn Bowls National
Championships. We'd like to
pursue other such events that bring
visitors to the area.

The club is a well-respected member of the lawn bowling community being only one of two clubs that have teams in the Saturday and midweek top two pennant divisions.

What we have to offer?

There is room for over thirty sponsorship advertising signs both inside the club grounds and outside facing the road. For aesthetic purposes, all signs will be 2000mm x 1000mm.

We are providing the same opportunity to small local businesses and franchises as well as multinationals.

What does it cost?

Depending on your requirements. We have many positions in and around the club that you can select.

The main signage positions are inside and outside boundary fencing for \$600 per year. Larger signs over the entry gate and internal signage space within the clubhouse are also available.
